

RULES FOR PG-FISIOCIRURGIA QUALIFICATION EXAM

The applicant to the masters or doctorate program must deliver 5 (FIVE) copies of the dissertation or thesis project to the PG-FISIOCIRURGIA secretariat, and a copy on CD, reproduced in a way that guarantees their good graphic presentation, obeying the specific rules defined on the matter by CC-FISIOCIRURGIA, up to 30 (thirty) days in advance of the expected date for qualification, however, a shorter interval may be granted, at the discretion of CC-FISIOCIRURGIA.

At the moment of the delivery, the applicant will receive a theme for the assessment of knowledge in the field of physiopathology, defined by CC-FISIOCIRURGIA.

The examining committee will comprise 3 (three) full professors and 1 (one) deputy, appointed by CC-FISIOCIRURGIA.

The candidate will be responsible for presenting his/her project, within a period not exceeding 20 (twenty) minutes, in the case of the Masters Degree, and 25 (twenty-five) minutes, in the case of the Doctorate Degree. The applicant must demonstrate what has already been accomplished and what is still to be accomplished. At the end of the presentation, the candidate will be argued in the form of dialogue, for a period not exceeding 10 (ten) minutes for each member of the committee, who will comment on the project, issuing a written opinion with the evaluation result, within a maximum period of 15 (fifteen) days.

The applicant whose dissertation project is considered insufficient may submit to a new exam within a maximum period of three (3) months after the first evaluation. The candidate who fails the second time in the qualification exam will be dismissed from PG-FISIOCIRURGIA.
