COURSE DESCRIPTION

The objective of this course is to familiarize the graduate student with the main sources of funds and research funding agencies and to clarify the purpose of each agency. We will discuss how to prepare a research project, and to which agency the project can be sent. In addition to financial aid for projects, applications for initiation, improvement, technical support doctoral scholarships abroad (sandwich), etc., will also be discussed. The possibilities of short-term aids, such as participation in congresses and events, holding of congresses and events, and special aids, such as publishing, etc., will be addressed. Themes will be presented in a theoretical way and, later, in a practical way, with the student visiting the websites of the agencies, preparing a project and submitting it, together with the supervisor, to one of the agencies.
